The transient time to analyze such loops can add further error to the analysis. This presentation will include description of all observation errors, analysis of the size of such errors and a method to correctly determine loop size.</p> <p data-bbox="375 1012 1279 1232"><i>Fault Analysis and Correction</i> - Capt Pete Greenan, FFF CBOG Recognizing casting faults, understanding what caused the fault and how to correct the fault is the focus of this presentation.
